9. ADMISSION & WITHDRAWAL

Admission

- Admission is open to all children irrespective of race, religion, nationalities, caste or gender.
- Admission of a child to a class is based on an admission test and further interaction with the admission committee.
- Admission of a child into a class is subject to seat availability and fulfillment of other admission criteria including age criteria as laid down by the state government/CBSE.
- Sibling (only directly related ones) may be given preference.
- GR number will be issued to a child only after all prescribed documents including Medical Certificate from Jayaben Modi Hospital are submitted to the office.

<u>Withdrawal</u>

- A child can be withdrawn from school after clearing all dues.
- Parent should complete the LC/TC application form available with the school office.
- Parents who would be withdrawing their children at the end of an academic year should submit the LC/TC application by 1st March 2024.
- Application for LC/TC received after 1st March shall be processed only after applicable fees (tuition fees & term fee) for the next session are paid. Verbal intimation/request shall not be considered.
- Parents must ensure all pending documents pertaining to your child's admission at LIA are submitted at office, otherwise LC/TC will not be issued.

10. SCHOOL DISCIPLINE

Discipline of a child is essential for his/her personality development. The objective is to inculcate a sense of control, self-discipline and self-direction.

General Guidelines:

- Students must be present in the school before the assembly commences.
- School prefects must be given due respect.
- Care should be taken in keeping the school campus clean always. Litter must be disposed off in the dustbins provided.
- Students are expected to take good care of their belongings while at school. The school will not take any responsibility for any lost articles, including money or valuables which are not advisable to be brought to school in quantities in excess of bare necessities.
- Students must come to school in neat, tidy and in complete uniform. ID cards should be worn on all school days.
- Use of plastics is banned in the school. Don't bring polythene bags.
- Aerated drinks such as Cola, Pepsi and readymade wafers, chips etc.. should not be brought to school.
- Only Vegetarian food should be brought to school as tiffin.

The following in general, will be considered as acts of indiscipline:

- Any disagreeable act or violation of school rules and norms
- Misconduct in the campus, classrooms & examination hall
- Malpractice in Assessment/Examinations and tampering with examination records.
- Late coming
- Non-conformity to School uniform
- Abstaining from P.E/Library/Co-scholastic classes or club activities
- Possession of objectionable print and non-print materials.
- Use of abusive and inappropriate language
- Theft
- Bullying other children & inflicting physical injury to others.
- Disrespect to National Anthem, National Flag etc.
- Disrespect to teaching, non-teaching staff and school prefects
- Damage to school property etc.

All the above acts will be treated as 'Gross Misconduct' and adequate corrective measures will be taken as noted hereunder

- Notification to parent
- Counselling
- Warning by concerned teacher
- Report to the Vice-Principal/ Principal
- Invalidation of the answer-script and/or other suitable measures.
- Permanent/habitual late-comers will be sent back
- Entry in the student record
- Withdrawal of all facilities provided by the school.
- Deprivation of honour-rolls, certificates, awards.
- Replacement of or financial compensation to damage of school property.
- Suspension
- Expulsion

11. FEE RULES

- School fees must be paid before 20th of every month. Late payment will attract a penalty of Rs 150/- per month.
- Use only the fee challan issued by the school to pay fee at the bank.
 No cash payment will be accepted at the school office.
- If parents fail to pay the fees of their children for more than two months then his/her name will be struck off from the roll without any intimation.
- If a student's name is on the school roll for even a single day of the month fees have to be paid for the entire month.
- Students joining late must pay fee for the entire academic year.
- Fees once paid will not be refundable.
- Fee will be increased, if required, every year by a maximum 10% only.

12. DRESS CODE FOR BOYS

- The Regular Uniform is Charcoal Grey pants and Light Lemon plain yellow shirt with school logo on the pocket (Mafatlal Suiting & Shirting), Grey socks, belt and black shoes.
- 2. The sports uniform is grey track pants with single
 - ✓ charcoal lining on each leg side & grey coloured collar
 - \checkmark T-shirt with house colour strips on sleeves and chest sides.
- Prescribed sports shoes should be worn along with sports uniform. However, for class I-IV regular shoes should be worn along with sports uniforms. Sports shoes is applicable only for classes V-X.
- Boys are obliged to wear the school uniform on excursions, picnics and to all school related functions and activities unless otherwise stated with permission from the Principal.
- 5. If pupils fail to comply with regulations relating to school uniform and personal appearance, the school will then exercise its right to restrict the pupil's access to the school and participation in the school related activity.
- Hair must always be short and neat. Bleaching, dying and fashionable styles are not permissible. Use of hair gel is prohibited.
- 7. Except for simple wristwatches, no other jewellery is permitted.
- 8. Coloured contact lenses will not be permitted.
- 9. Fingernails are to be kept short.
- 10. Sports shoes should be worn on Wednesdays and Saturdays along with sports uniforms.
- 11. Neatly pressed uniform should be worn to school.

13. DRESS CODE FOR GIRLS

- The Regular Uniform is Charcoal Grey Pinafore and light Lemon Plain Yellow Shirt with school logo on the pinafore and pocket of the shirt (Mafatalal Suiting & Shirting), Grey socks, belt & black shoes.
- The sports uniform is grey track pants with single charcoal lining on each leg side & grey coloured collar T-shirt with house colour strips on sleeves and chest sides.
- Prescribed sports shoes should be worn along with sports uniform. However, for class I-IV regular shoes should be worn along with sports uniforms. Sports shoes is applicable only for classes V-X.
- 4. Girls should make two pleated hair with black bow to each pleat of hair.
- Girls are obliged to wear the school uniform on excursions and to all school related functions and activities unless otherwise stated with permission from the Principal.
- 6. If pupils fail to comply with regulations relating to school uniform and personal appearance, the school will then exercise its right to restrict the pupil's access to the school and participation in the school related activity.
- 7. Except for simple wristwatches, no other jewellery is permitted.
- 8. Fingernails are to be kept short; nail polish is prohibited.
- 9. All kinds of make-up including lip gloss is prohibited.
- 10. Coloured contact lenses will not be permitted.
- 11. Sports shoes (Class V onwards) should be worn on Wednesdays and Saturdays along with sports uniforms.
- 12. Neatly pressed uniform should be worn to school.
- 13. Parents can collect further details on student's dress code from the school's office.

14. INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

- Besides periodic circulars sent out to parents to keep updated of the school's programmes, the learner's diary serves as a regular channel of communication between parents and teachers. We earnestly request the parents to have a close look at the learner's diary every day. The teachers will communicate with you through this handbook. Your prompt attention to their remarks is essential.
- Criticism of teacher should be avoided in the presence of the child because it undermines his/her respect for the teacher and the school.
- Parents must take the opportunity to meet the teachers and discuss the progress of their ward on meetings days informed to them by the school.
- 4. Please ensure that your ward is invariably punctual; late comers will not be permitted entry.
- Attention should be paid by parents on the child's regular attendance, practice work, cleanliness, discipline and dress code regulation.
- 6. Please do not allow your wards to carry mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets and prohibited items to the classroom. Students are also not permitted to drive car/scooter/motor bikes to the school without a valid license. Students driving motor vehicles to school without a valid licence will be denied entry into the school.
- 7. Parents should make use of the format given in serial no 25 for advance leave application. Kindly use A4 size paper for all applications. Kindly use serial No. 24 for up to two days of absence/leave.
- Parents should ensure that their wards, if suffering from any communicable diseases are not sent to school until he/she is fully recovered.
- Parents are requested not to enter the classrooms during school hours. In an emergency written permission must be taken from the principal.

10. Parents are requested to refrain from coming to school in the midst of school hours to take their wards home unless intimated to parents by the school. In case of an emergency the same should be reported to the principal who will look into the matter.

- 11. Students will not be granted leave during school hours. Leave will not be sanctioned for going out for functions or other petty reasons.
- Parents should drop and pick up their wards from the entry /exit gate. They should refrain from entering the school corridors for any unofficial reasons.
- 13. Any change in residential address, status, contact no's. etc should be updated in the school record by sending a note and the changes thereof to the school office/Class Teacher.
- 14. Parents are allowed to meet Class Teachers and Respective subject teachers only on 2nd Saturdays between 8:30am and 10:00am. On other days they must get a written permission from the principal.
- 15. Complaints regarding the progress of a child's studies must first be consulted with the principal and then only to the class teacher. Suggestions are welcome, but the words of principal and the school authority will be final.
- 16. Parents are requested to meet the principal or the class teachers personally without any delay whenever they are called.
- 17. Parents are requested to be polite and considerate to all staff of the school.

17. MODE OF ASSESSMENT

1. Class I-II:

Assessment will be term based (Term I & Term II). Report card will be issued after end of each term. Marks & grades will be reflected in the report card. Each Term Assessment will consist of Periodic Assessment (Periodic Test, Multiple Assessments, and Subject Enrichment Activities & Notebook). There will be a Term Test at the end of each term.

2. Class III-V:

Assessment will be term based (Term I & Term II). Report card will be issued after end of each term. Marks &grades will be reflected in the report card. Each Term Assessment will consist of Periodic Assessment (Periodic Test, Multiple Assessments, and Subject Enrichment Activities & Notebook). There will be a Term Test at the end of each term.

3. Class VI-VIII:

Assessment will be term based (Term I & Term II). Report card will be issued after end of each term. Marks grades will be reflected in the report card. Each Term Assessment will consist of Periodic Assessment (Periodic Test, Multiple Assessments, Subject Enrichment Activities &Portfolio/Notebook).There will be a Term Test at the end of each term.

4. Class IX-X:

Assessment will be according to board pattern. Report card for class IX will be issued after end of the academic session. Marks grades will be reflected in the report card. Assessment will consist of Periodic Assessment (Periodic Test, Multiple Assessments, Subject Enrichment Activities & Portfolio / Notebook).

No Re-test or Weightage will be given to a student who misses any assessment. Hence regular attending class is mandatory for a child.

In case a child remains absent on medical ground it is on the onus of the parent of the child to submit a valid medical certificate.

18. PROMOTION RULES

Class I-V

Class I-V will have a 'liberal promotion' policy. Remedial programmes will be conducted to minimise failures. A minimum of 80% attendance is mandatory for promotion to the next class.

Class VI-X

A minimum of 33% is required in each scholastic subject and a minimum D grade in Co-Scholastic Subjects along with a minimum of 80% attendance in aggregate.

A candidate having less than 80% attendance will not be eligible for promotion to a higher class.

Note: Any special case will be reviewed by the Exam Committee.
